## **WHEN DO THE SIRENS SOUND?**

Activation occurs under the following conditions:

- 1.) A tornado warning is issued for any part of Delaware County by the National Weather Service;
- 2.) A tornado or funnel cloud is sighted by current public safety personnel, or;
- 3.) Other large scale emergencies, such as imminent dam failure, etc.

During a tornado warning, sirens will sound for three minutes, every ten minutes, until the warning has expired.
